



God sees behind our \_\_\_\_\_. He's not tricked by our con games. He's not deceived by our deceptions. He knows what's in our hearts and lives.

Later in Psalm 139, David talks about his faith in God's goodness by saying: "How precious to me are your thoughts, O God!" Will God's seeing behind our masks / seeing beyond our pretending actually be precious to us?

Through Jesus, three things need to happen in our lives to escape drought & dryness and FIND HEALING. There must be:

- 1) A confronting of sin;
- 2) A coming in \_\_\_\_\_ and truth;
- 3) A confessing of Jesus as Savior.

Our greatest danger isn't our sin, but it's our refusal to trust the Father with our sin.

We are dry of soul because our sin separates us from the fountain. But listen to God's grace: "Come, everyone who thirsts, come to the waters..." It's good news and it's free – but know this: \_\_\_\_\_ can come to a holy God without confronting their sin. The path out of dryness leads to a holy God through a sin-forgiving Jesus.

We are supposed to worship God – in fact, God is looking for \_\_\_\_\_.

- 1.) It starts with reverence and praise.
- 2.) Humility
- 3.) Joyful thankfulness

Worship must be in spirit. Spiritual worship is about \_\_\_\_\_ your heart to God, rather than being content with ceremony.

Worship must be in truth. God cannot be known apart from truth, apart from worship which conforms to Scripture.

Those who believe - own their sin, take off their masks, and come just as they are to the Father for forgiveness and life.
